ATTENDANCE

Please contact the studio via email if you will be missing class so the instructor can be notified. There is no pro-rating for missed classes. Students are encouraged to make-up missed classes within a month of their absence. All class make-ups must be scheduled through the studio office.

DANCE ATTIRE

All students are required to wear appropriate dance attire to class: leotards with either tights, fitted dance shorts or leggings. No school or play clothes, loose fitting t-shirts, jeans or loose shorts. Loose fit joggers may be worn for hip hop.

Hair must be tightly secured and off the face and neck with either a pony tail, bun or braids. **Ballet students** are required to wear a solid black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes and a bun in their hair.

REQUIRED SHOE COLOR (please label all shoes with your name)

Pre-school and Kindergarten Tap/Ballet/Tumble combo classes: black Mary Jane style or ribbon-tie tap shoes & pink ballet shoes

Combo Tap/Jazz classes for 5-8 year olds: black tap shoes & tan jazz shoes.

Tap classes: black, lace-up full sole, tap shoes with a firm toe box. (NO MaryJane buckle, Velcro or single ribbon style tap shoes)

Jazz & Musical Theater classes: tan jazz shoes (Dance Company is required to wear Bloch Pulse style jazz shoes for performances)

Ballet classes: pink ballet shoes (Canvas ballet shoes are preferred for ballet classes ages 8+)

Hip-hop classes: For class: any color **clean, indoor-only** sneaker. For performance: solid black sneakers

Please do not wear hip-hop sneakers outside in the parking lot, sidewalk, street or grass. This will transfer dirt, salt and residue onto our dance floors.

Lyrical & Contemporary classes: lyrical half-shoes

CLASS PLACEMENT

All students will be evaluated during the first few weeks of class. The placement of each student is at the instructor's discretion. If a student is enrolled in a class that is not an appropriate level, it is to the advantage of the student that they are placed in the correct class.

LOST ITEMS

The studio is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please mark your name inside all shoes, bags, coats etc. and bring any valuables into class with you. Check the lost and found for any misplaced items before the end of the month, as unclaimed items will be donated.

CELL PHONES

The use of cell phones is not permitted during class. Students who need to use their phone during class should ask their instructor for permission to step into the lobby before using their phone.

WEATHER

In the event of severe weather, families will be notified of canceled classes via email. Notifications will also be posted on the website and social media pages (Instagram and Facebook).

TUITION DUE DATES

Upon enrollment:	1st Quarter Tuition Payment
November 9, 2020 :	2nd Quarter Tuition Payment
January 25, 2021:	3rd Quarter Tuition Payment
April 11, 2021:	4th Quarter Tuition Payment

- Tuition rates are determined by a family's total number of weekly dance hours.
- Tuition rates have been discounted for families taking two or more class hours per week.
- Tuition is paid in four equal installments through the automatic/recurring payment plan with the credit card or bank card associated with the family's studio account. .
- There is an option to pay by check, cash, Zelle or Chase QuickPay before the beginning of each quarter. Families will still need to have a credit card on file. If payment is not received by the third day of the new quarter, tuition will be processed through the automatic payment feature.
- Tuition can be prorated for students who enroll after the start of the new dance season.
- Optional payment plans are available. Please contact the studio for more information.
- Late fees of \$15 will be enforced on all accounts that are 7 days past due.
- There is a \$25 fee for all returned checks.
- There are no refunds on tuition once a class begins. Class credit will be issued.
